Dear Guidance Counselors, Educators and Scholarship Chairs:

The Kobrin Family created the Kobrin Family Scholarship in 1990 to be awarded to a qualified student from Orange, Osceola or Seminole County who will be attending the University of Central Florida. **Please note that this scholarship is only available to students of the Jewish faith.**

The scholarship is available to a qualified, full-time student in the amount of \$2,500 per year for a maximum of four (4) years. The student must maintain a 3.2 GPA (based on a 4.0 scale) each year in order to remain qualified for the scholarship.

Enclosed you will find an application and a criteria/requirement sheet to distribute to your graduating Jewish students. Please feel free to duplicate any of the materials.

THE KOBRIN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

The Kobrin Family, in 1990, established the Kobrin Family Scholarship Fund for qualified students in the Central Florida area. The scholarship is to be used ONLY at the University of Central Florida by a student from Orange, Osceola or Seminole County. **Please note that this scholarship is only available to students of the Jewish faith.**

The scholarship is available to a qualified full-time student in the amount of \$2,500 per year for a maximum of four (4) years. The student must maintain a 3.2 GPA each year in order to remain qualified for the scholarship. The scholarship is disbursed directly to UCF in the amount of \$1,250 for each of the incoming fall and spring semesters.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- A completed application packet
- Student must be accepted at and planning to attend the University of Central Florida as a full-time student
- Financial need as demonstrated by the Student Aid Report (SAR) from the FAFSA
- Resident of Orange, Osceola or Seminole County
- High school GPA of at least 3.2 based on a 4.0 scale
- SAT test score of at least 1400 (Reading + Math) or a minimum ACT composite score of 27
- School/Community involvement during high school
- Overall quality of the application

REQUIREMENTS: A completed application packet submitted by the deadline. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Please check off requirements as you complete them.

- The application form
- A copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) from the FAFSA
- An official high school transcript, including both district (weighted) and state (Unweighted) GPAs, reflecting first semester grades from the 12th grade year, as well as SAT and/or ACT scores
- School and community activities during high school
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation, one (1) from a school-related person and one (1) from a non-school related person
- Personal statement (Maximum five hundred {500} words, typed)
